Declaration of Intent “No Gift Policy” Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

As an executive responsibility for the management of the Chiang Mai University Academic Service Center, I hereby declare the **No Gift Policy** and affirm the commitment of all executives and staff to uphold the principles of transparency, ethics, and integrity. The Academic Service Center will not accept gifts or any kind of gratuities arising from the performance of duties.

We are committed to fostering values and practices that reflect ethical conduct, integrity, and transparency. This includes refraining from accepting any property, gifts, or gratuities that may be perceived as a conflict between personal interests and public benefits and/or that might lead to favoritism or undue advantages for stakeholders in connection with the operations of the Academic Service Center. Exceptions apply only to property or benefits legally permissible under laws, regulations, or ordinances issued under statutory authority.

Additionally, all staff will strictly adhere to the ethical standards and codes of conduct applicable to government officials and members of Chiang Mai University. This commitment ensures alignment with principles of good governance and reinforces a culture of integrity and transparency within the organization.
